Mrs. Bisesti introduces explaining the purpose of the meeting today.

There is debate about how to conduct the study tour. We agree about the absence on the Italian territory of a plant for the production of biomethane. It was decided therefore to go to Sweden to visit real significant plants on the basis of valid proposals received from the foreign partner of the project. In particular the possibility to visit AD plants in Vejxo area. The subjects to be involved will be given by participants of the Advisory Committee (AC), on the basis of the following parameters:

- 1. to be potencial investors or entrepreneurs
- 2. to be local administrators in whose territory there is an authorization procedure for biogas plant or an already authorized plant.

The members of the AD are asked to indicate potencial investors on the territory, and to indicate fairs, seminars or events to give presentations on the biogas/biomethane. For the purposes of the promotion all presents are asked to indicate all the possible initiatives to promote the biomethane locally.

As to the deliverable D.4.3.4 it was agreed that input to the new regional rural plan will given in order to include biogas and biomethane in the priorities. Moreover, the same actions will be taken in the municipal action plans in municipalities to be spotted in the next months.

Since a local transport body (ARPA) is member of the AD it was agreed that ARPA will sign an agreement to include biomethane as fuel to be used, when allowed by law.

This report was formally reviewed and approved. At the meeting closed at 17.30.
