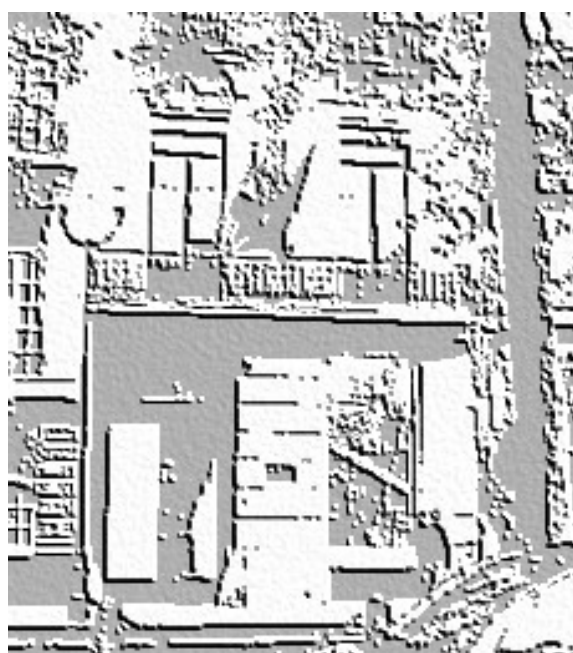

Si è svolta lo scorso **4 dicembre** presso il **Consolato Generale d'Italia a Liegi**, la cerimonia di consegna dei **fondi raccolti** presso la stessa Circonscrizione Consolare in favore delle vittime del terremoto.

Alla presenza del Console Generale, **Mauro CARFAGNINI**, hanno preso parte alla cerimonia il Governatore della Provincia di Liegi, **Michel FORET**, il Sindaco di Herstal, **Frédéric DAERDEN**, il Presidente dell'Associazione "Sol.Italia" **Gerard APRUZZESE**, oltre ad un funzionario dell'**Ufficio di Bruxelles della Regione Abruzzo** e diversi rappresentanti della stampa locale.

GLI EUROPEI CAUTAMENTE OTTIMISTI PER L'ECONOMIA MA PREOCCUPATI PER LA DISOCCUPAZIONE

I primi risultati dell'ultima indagine Eurobarometro (autunno 2009) rivelano che per gli europei il problema principale per il loro paese è la disoccupazione, mentre le preoccupazioni circa la situazione economica sono leggermente diminuite. Tuttavia una maggioranza teme che il peggio della crisi debba ancora venire. Ora che il G20 e l'FMI hanno impresso un maggior slancio al risanamento economico, i cittadini ritengono che i governi nazionali e l'Unione europea occupino la posizione migliore per agire contro gli effetti della crisi.

"I cittadini hanno chiaramente definito il lavoro come la loro principale preoccupazione e l'UE deve continuare a prestare tutta la sua attenzione e ad impegnarsi pienamente nella lotta contro la crisi", così ha dichiarato **Margot Wallström, Vice-presidente della Commissione europea**, responsabile dei rapporti istituzionali e della strategia delle comunicazioni.

La maggior parte degli europei (54%, -7 punti rispetto a maggio-giugno 2009) ritengono che il peggio debba ancora venire per quanto riguarda l'impatto della crisi sul lavoro, mentre il 38% considera che essa abbia già raggiunto il suo apice. Questa percentuale corrisponde ad un aumento del 10% rispetto all'indagine precedente.

La stessa tendenza positiva, rispetto a quella della primavera 2009, si può osservare riguardo alle aspettative in materia di situazione economica nell'UE, nel corso dei prossimi 12 mesi. Il 30% (+6) degli europei è del parere che i prossimi dodici mesi saranno migliori, il 38% considera che la situazione rimarrà immutata (-) e il 21% (-7) si aspetta un peggioramento. L'11% (+1) dei cittadini non si pronuncia.

Aspettative analoghe più positive sono state registrate per il futuro dell'economia mondiale: il 29% (+5) dei cittadini ritiene che i prossimi 12 mesi saranno migliori, il 36% (-) pensa che saranno uguali e il 24% (-6) teme un peggioramento. L'11% (+1) non si pronuncia.

Riguardo alle aspettative sull'economia nazionale, la tendenza positiva è più moderata. Una maggior percentuale di europei ritiene che la situazione globale della loro economia nazionale rimarrà immutata (37%, +1) o peggiorerà (31%, -3), piuttosto che migliorare (28%, +3). Il 4% non si pronuncia.

Una maggioranza (51%, +2) delle persone interrogate considera la disoccupazione come il problema attualmente più importante nel proprio paese. La situazione economica viene al secondo posto (40%, -2) mentre l'inflazione (19%, -2) occupa il terzo posto assieme alla criminalità (19%, +3). A livello personale, l'inflazione (38%, immutato), la situazione economica (26%, immutato) e la disoccupazione (20%, -1) rimangono i tre temi più importanti.

L'Unione europea (22%, +2) e i governi nazionali (19%, +7) sono considerati come le istanze maggiormente in grado di fronteggiare la crisi. Sono seguiti da vicino dal G20 (18%, -2) che dalla primavera ha perso la sua seconda posizione a vantaggio dei governi nazionali.

Per gli europei lo stimolo della ricerca e dell'innovazione nell'industria europea (31%), il sostegno della produzione ecologica di beni e servizi (30%), il sostegno dell'agricoltura (27%) e l'incentivo alla creazione di imprese (25%), costituiscono i migliori mezzi per incoraggiare la crescita in maniera sostenibile.

Gli indicatori di tendenze relative alla fiducia nelle istituzioni europee sono stabili. Nell'insieme, il 50% (+2) dei cittadini europei tende a nutrire fiducia nel Parlamento europeo mentre il 33% (-3) non ce l'ha. Il 46% (+2) ha maggior fiducia nella Commissione europea e il 32% (-2) non ce l'ha.

La maggioranza degli europei (53%, immutato) continua a percepire l'adesione del loro paese all'UE come una buona cosa mentre il 57% (+1) ritiene che il rispettivo paese abbia tratto vantaggio dall'essere membro dell'UE.

Dall'autunno 2007 sembra esserci stata un'inversione nella valutazione del modo in cui opera la democrazia. Il 53% (-5) delle persone interrogate è soddisfatto del funzionamento della democrazia nel rispettivo paese mentre la percentuale relativa all'Unione europea è del 54% (+2). Due anni fa, il modo in cui la democrazia funzionava a livello nazionale (58%) era considerato più soddisfacente che a livello UE (52%).

Questa indagine "Eurobarometro standard" è stata condotta sotto forma di interviste personali da parte della TNS Opinion & Social. Fra il 23 ottobre e il 18 novembre 2009 sono state intervistate 30 238 persone. Le indagini Eurobarometro standard si svolgono due volte all'anno, in primavera e in autunno.

QUALIFICHE PROFESSIONALI: LA COMMISSIONE INFORMA MEGLIO SUL FUNZIONAMENTO DELLA NORMATIVA EUROPEA

La Commissione europea ha pubblicato un documento che illustra in quale misura i singoli Stati membri dell'UE hanno attuato la direttiva sulle qualifiche professionali. Il documento è accompagnato da una guida in cui i cittadini possono trovare informazioni circa il contenuto e gli effetti della direttiva, adottata nel 2005 per facilitare la libera circolazione delle persone che desiderano esercitare, stabilmente o temporaneamente, un'attività lavorativa autonoma o dipendente in un altro Stato membro.

Il commissario europeo per il mercato interno e i servizi Charlie McCreevy ha dichiarato: "Questa guida fornisce ai professionisti informazioni preziose su come far valere i loro diritti nel mercato interno. Per quanto riguarda la trasposizione della direttiva nell'ordinamento giuridico nazionale, invito gli Stati membri in ritardo ad attuare al più presto questo importante atto normativo."

Panoramica sull'attuazione della direttiva

Tutti gli Stati membri avrebbero dovuto attuare la direttiva entro il 20 ottobre 2007. Oltre due anni dopo la scadenza di questo termine, cinque Paesi (Austria, Belgio, Francia, Grecia e Lussemburgo) non hanno ancora ottemperato a tale obbligo. Il documento pubblicato oggi dalla Commissione presenta una panoramica dettagliata del modo in cui gli Stati membri hanno dato attuazione alla direttiva.

Guida

La Commissione ha inoltre pubblicato una guida di 66 domande e risposte per informare i lavoratori, sia autonomi sia dipendenti, su come ottenere il riconoscimento delle loro qualifiche in un altro Stato membro dell'UE. Ad esempio, la guida spiega come avvalersi della direttiva per lavorare temporaneamente in un altro Paese dell'Unione.

La direttiva sulle qualifiche professionali

La direttiva 2005/36/CE relativa al riconoscimento delle qualifiche professionali è un elemento fondamentale della legislazione relativa al mercato interno. Essa si applica a oltre 800 professioni regolamentate, cioè professioni per il cui esercizio uno o più Paesi dell'Unione europea richiedono il possesso di determinate qualifiche. Alcuni professionisti del settore sanitario e gli architetti beneficiano del riconoscimento automatico dei titoli ottenuti nel loro Paese d'origine perché le condizioni cui è subordinata l'attribuzione di questi titoli sono armonizzate al livello europeo. Il riconoscimento è automatico anche per gli artigiani che abbiano maturato una certa esperienza

professionale nel loro Paese d'origine. Per le altre professioni, la direttiva prevede un sistema di riconoscimento reciproco dei titoli caso per caso, in modo da consentire alle persone qualificate di ottenere il riconoscimento dei loro titoli nello Stato membro ospitante in cui desiderano esercitare la loro attività.

CON 1,5 MLD DI EURO LA COMMISSIONE INCENTIVA LE NUOVE TECNOLOGIE IN MATERIA AMBIENTALE

La Commissione ha approvato oggi 15 progetti nel settore energetico che contribuiranno in maniera significativa alla ripresa economica dell'UE, potenziando nel contempo la sicurezza dell'approvvigionamento e riducendo notevolmente le emissioni di CO₂. Tra questi, un progetto italiano, presentato dall'Enel per la cattura e lo stoccaggio delle emissioni di una centrale a Porto Tolle (RO).

Andris Piebalgs, commissario per l'energia, ha dichiarato in proposito: "Con questa decisione la Commissione getta le basi per lo sviluppo di due tecnologie sostenibili cruciali, che saranno essenziali nella lotta contro i cambiamenti climatici. Questa decisione senza precedenti non solo dà impulso all'economia e all'occupazione, ma sostiene anche tecnologie innovative nel settore energetico che in futuro potranno creare più posti di lavoro e favorire la crescita."

Promuovendo la tecnologia di CCS (cattura e stoccaggio del carbonio) con 1 miliardo di euro assegnato a sei progetti, la Commissione riconosce l'importanza costante dell'energia ottenuta da combustibili fossili e la necessità di adeguarsi ad un sistema energetico a basse emissioni di carbonio. I progetti nel settore dell'energia eolica offshore, a nove dei quali andranno 565 milioni di euro, favoriscono lo sviluppo e il consolidamento di un settore competitivo in Europa e creano numerosi posti di lavoro "ecologici". Per l'Italia è stato ammesso il progetto presentato da Enel Ingegneria e Innovazione S.p.A. per l'installazione di tecnologia CCS su una nuova unità da 660MW della centrale a carbone di Porto Tolle (Rovigo). La cattura interesserà le emissioni corrispondenti a una produzione di 250 MW di energia elettrica e lo stoccaggio avverrà in una vicina falda acquifera salina.

Questi progetti innovativi e premiati contribuiranno a raggiungere gli obiettivi vincolanti in termini di riduzione delle emissioni di gas a effetto serra e di energie rinnovabili entro il 2020 e oltre.

La decisione relativa ai 15 progetti è il primo passo verso un utilizzo ottimale dei quasi 4 milioni di euro che a maggio 2009 l'UE ha accantonato per progetti nel settore energetico volti a sostenere la ripresa economica. L'accordo storico sul programma energetico europeo per la ripresa, concluso a maggio, prevede che l'Unione conceda assistenza finanziaria a progetti nei settori di CCS, energia eolica offshore e infrastrutture per elettricità e

gas. Le procedure relative ai progetti infrastrutturali sono in corso e si prevede che la relativa decisione venga presa a febbraio 2010.

MANIFESTO PER LA CREATIVITÀ E L'INNOVAZIONE IN EUROPA

La Commissione europea ha proposto al Consiglio una proroga di 15 mesi per le misure antidumping relative alle calzature di cuoio provenienti dalla Cina e dal Vietnam. I dazi, del 16,5% sulle calzature cinesi e del 10% su quelle vietnamite, sono stati imposti nel 2006. Su domanda dell'industria, la Commissione ha svolto un'inchiesta diretta a stabilire se le misure debbano continuare dopo la data di scadenza normale. Secondo l'inchiesta, la proroga delle misure sarebbe giustificata.

L'inchiesta, iniziata nell'ottobre 2008, ha rilevato che, nonostante i dazi, le scarpe di cuoio cinesi e vietnamite continuano a essere vendute in dumping sul mercato europeo. Anche se le misure hanno arginato in parte gli effetti del dumping, questo comportamento contrario alla concorrenza ha continuato a causare notevoli danni ai produttori UE che stanno sforzandosi di adeguare i loro modelli commerciali.

Abolire le misure in questo momento farebbe aumentare il dumping e il relativo pregiudizio e potrebbe bloccare il processo di adeguamento di un'industria che nell'UE occupa oltre 260.000 lavoratori. Inoltre, dall'inchiesta non risulta che i dazi abbiano avuto significativi effetti dannosi sui consumatori o sui distributori: i prezzi al consumo sono rimasti praticamente stabili, mentre i profitti dei distributori, pur essendo più modesti, sono superiori al 20%. La stabilità dei prezzi riflette il livello relativamente basso dei dazi (compreso tra il 9,7% e il 16,5% dei prezzi d'importazione): in media, su un paio di scarpe venduto al dettaglio a 50 euro e importato a circa 9 euro, viene prelevato un dazio inferiore a 1,5 euro.

In base a questi elementi, le regole antidumping della UE giustificano la proroga delle misure.

Nella sua raccomandazione la Commissione ha tuttavia proposto una proroga di 15 mesi, invece che di 5 anni (il massimo consentito dalle norme), perché dall'inchiesta risulta che il processo di adeguamento dell'industria è ben avviato. Dall'inchiesta emerge che dopo l'aprile 2011 è improbabile che l'industria europea risentirà in misura significativa delle importazioni cinesi e vietnamite. Una proroga di 15 mesi basta dunque a rimuovere il pregiudizio e minimizza tutti gli effetti sulle parti interessate.

Nel preparare la raccomandazione, la Commissione ha accuratamente ponderato i risultati dell'inchiesta, le osservazioni di tutte le parti interessate e il parere tecnico di esperti degli Stati membri.

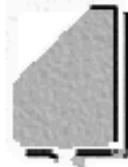
Spetta ora agli Stati membri prendere una decisione, che dovrebbe essere pubblicata entro il 2 gennaio 2010.

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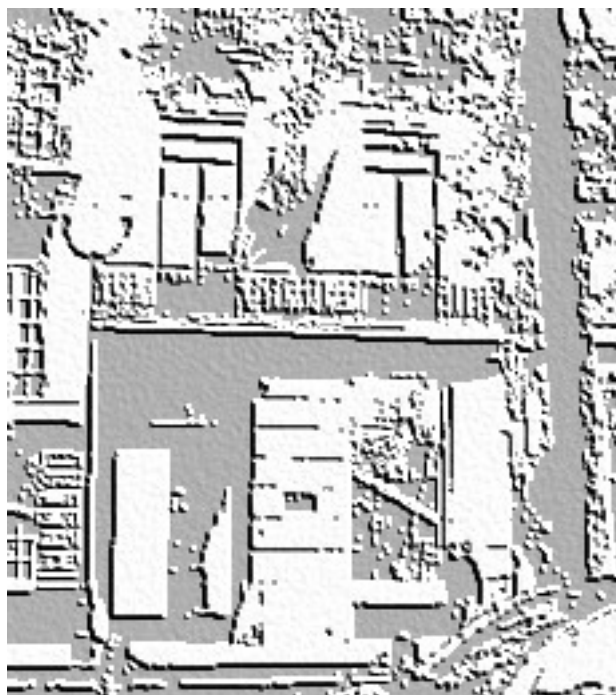

Basic data underlying the need for implementation of the project

The Andalusian work market has undergone great modifications in the last three years due to the crisis of the construction sector. This branch of activity has worked during years like a powerful generator of direct and indirect use in other branches of the production, are industrialists or of services, like real

estate promoters, companies, suppliers of constructors and subcontractors among others. Many of them surpass the 45 years of age. The number of visits to realize will depend of the needs detected during the development of the project. It is foreseen at least one visit in each territory.

Activity 2: Elaboration of the study/diagnostic about the models of public employment service

To realize the study, we will put in place the following activities:

- Documental review from reports, administrative documentation, information of the data bases from the structures and employment services
- Interviews to key persons/ informers from the services and/o the territory, who thanks to his/her work or knowledge in this field can give relevant information: responsible of public employment service, economic and social agent, representative of local association, etc.
- To establish a common conceptual framework in order to use it in the study because as we deal with a comparative analyze in different contexts it is important to homogenate a conceptualization and a terminology that can be reflected in the report.

In relation to the structure of the study it is foreseen the following section:

1. A description of the socioeconomic reality of the region as well as the labor market of the territory of the study
2. Description of public employment service models and of the main employment policies carried out, which will make understanding thoroughly the most relevant aspects and the main challenges to deal with in terms of employment.
3. A comparative analyze of the three models in which we can underline the aspects that constitute plus value for the study.
4. Recompile of the best practices, its innovative elements and the most successful experiences as well as the pattern elements in order to transfer them to other contexts.

Finally, the study foresees a series of recommendations and proposals for a possible transfer of the models to other contexts.

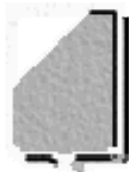

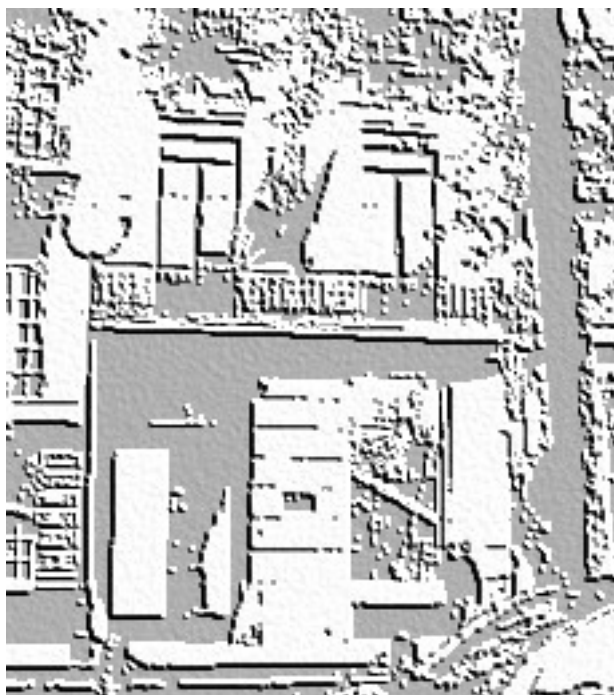
