

«OPEN DOORS DAY» AT THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTIONS- THE ABRUZZO REGION SHARES THE BOOTH «ParLuPRE.Ab » WITH THE PARDUBICE REGION (CZ) THE LUBUSZ VOIVDESHIP (PL) AND THE PRESOV REGION (SK)

On 12 May, the Abruzzo Region will take part in the “**Open Doors Day**” at the **European Institutions** or the fourth consecutive year. With this event, the Institutions celebrate the anniversary of the **Schumann Declaration** that launched the **process of Community integration**.

Indeed, during those celebrations, the Committee of the Regions offers to **the representative regions in Brussels** the opportunity to present their regions sharing information and encouraging the participation of the regional and local authorities in the Community processes.

This year again, the Abruzzo Region will have its own **bigger booth** that it will share with its partner-regions, the **Pardubice Region(CZ)**, the **Lubusz Region(PL)** and the **Presov Region (SK)** under the name “*ParLuPre.Ab*”.

This year, the “**Open Doors Day**” will welcome forty or so regions representing more than fifteen States.

At every booth, the regions will present their **traditions, cultural heritage and tourist attractions**. The regions will be grouped according to their **Member States**. **Exhibitions, musical shows, dance performances and concerts** are also planned

Common interactive activities have been prepared with other partner regions. Those activities will entertain the visitors and will provide them information about the particularities and beauty of each region.

This initiative is a further step towards new **cooperation agreements** with the partner regions. This cooperation is one of the **objectives** of our office in Brussels.
