"YOUTH AND BRUSSELS BASED REGIONS", LAUNCH OF THE THIRD CALL: TWO YOUNG *ABRUZZESI* FOR EVS AT THE BRUSSELS' OFFICE. EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST BY THE 1st DECEMBER

Launch of the project's third call: **"Youth and Brussels based Regions"**. From today **until the 1st December**, all young people who meet the conditions for eligibility indicated in the **Public Notice** published on the Abruzzo Region's website (<u>http://goo.gl/hhRCfh</u>) can express their interests to be part of the following PLACEMENTS:

EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE – GROUP SPRING 1 = 4 placements from the 12^{th} January to the 12^{th} April 2015 (2 for the ABRUZZO Region, 1 for the LUBUSKIE Province and 1 for the PRESOV Region)

In order to do so, it is necessary to access (for those who are already registered) or to register on the project's website (<u>http://www.yBBregions.eu.org</u>) and complete your profile by clicking on the following tab: "INTEREST TYE WINTER1"

The EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE's conditions for eligibility are the following:

- to be between 18 and 25 years old

- to be born in the Abruzzo Region, in the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, in the LUBUSKIE Province or in the PRESOV Region, or to live in the Abruzzo Region, in the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, in the LUBUSKIE Province or in the PRESOV Region, or to study in a training establishment, even at university, in the Abruzzo Region, in the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, in the LUBUSKIE Province or in the PRESOV Region

- to work, or to be unemployed, or to be looking for a first job

Furthermore, a good knowledge of a foreign language (if possible English) will play an **important role**: the young people who will go to **Brussels** will work in a **multicultural** and **multilingual** context. They will have to interact with each other and will act as an "antenna" for the others who will follow them at home, via the online platform and the project's social networks accounts.

<u>EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE AND TRANSNATIONAL EXCHANGES IN THE</u> <u>REGIONS' OFFICES IN BRUSSELS</u>

"Youth and Brussels based Regions" is a European project promoted and coordinated by the Abruzzo Region, in partnership with the Dubrovnik-Neretva County (Croatia), the Lubuskie Province (Poland) and the Presov Region (Slovakia).

The project was approved by the European Commission and it is co-financed by the **"Youth in Action"** program. It shall take effect from the 1st May 2014 until the 30th April 2016. During that two-year period, it intends to send 80 young people, aged 18-30, in the respective regional offices in Brussels for European voluntary service (EVS) and transnational youth exchanges (TYE) programs.

The project was presented on the 17th May 2014 in Brussels, at the Committee of the Regions, during the Institutions' traditional "Open Doors Day".

The people who will benefit from that exceptional offer will be selected among unemployed young people (aged 18-30) as far as the **European voluntary service** program is concerned, and among young workers and unemployed young people aged 18-25 as far as the **transnational exchanges** program is concerned.

The conditions and the duration vary depending on the programs: the European voluntary service program lasts for **13 weeks** and the transnational exchanges program last for **2 weeks**. Food and accommodation expenses are covered, as well as the **travel** costs. As far as the European voluntary service program is concerned, the candidates selected will also receive a monthly **pocket money**.

Every aspect of the project, including the selection, will be managed **online**, on the website, in digital form, in order to ensure high level of objectivity, transparency and rapidity. All interested people who meet the conditions

for eligibility indicated in the public notice related to the first year are kindly invited to visit regularly the website to participate in surveys and other activities offered, but also to respond to notices as soon as they are posted on the website.

The activities' launch coincided with the **fifteenth anniversary** of the establishment of the Abruzzo Region's office in Brussels (**1999/2014**).

FIRST RESULTS

Five months after the launch, the project has already been very successful, with **6,200** visits on the website and over **260** registered users.

Among the registered users, **78** people (including **52** *abruzzesi*) asked to be part of the **first call** related to the first placement scheduled (**1 EVS from the 1**st **September to the 30**th **November**).

Furthermore, about **100** users participated in the informative survey related to the project's themes.

Next placement:

- **TRANSNATIONAL EXCHANGE "MULTILATERAL SPRING 1"** = 16 placements in total, among which 4 for the Abruzzo Region, from the 21st April to the 06th May 2015
