OPEN DAYS 2015: ROMANO PRODI WILL BE THE GUEST OF THE LOCAL EVENT IN PESCARA. IN BRUSSELS, THE ADRIATIC-IONIAN MACROREGION AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF HUMAN CAPITAL ARE THE SUBJECT OF DISCUSSIONS.

Also this year, the **Abruzzo Region** is taking part in the **Open Days** during the « **European Week of Regions and Cities** », the most important annual event which takes place in Brussels, concerning the question of regional policies and the exchange of good practices.

The initiative is promoted by the **European Committee of the Regions** and by the **Directorate-General for Regional and Urban Policy** from the European Commission.

This year, the event is taking place from the 12th to the 15th October and is titled: « *Europe's regions and cities: partners for investment and growth* ». The Open Days will also be present on the territories of the region through some decentralised events addressed to a wider public.

The Abruzzo Region is the protagonist of three distinct initiatives:

- The 14th September, in PESCARA: as part of the local events, the President Emeritus of the European Commission, Romano Prodi, will be invited to a meeting regarding the future of Europe. In addition to the president of the Abruzzo Region, the protagonists of this meeting will be: Luciano d'Alfonso, the Professor Lucio Caracciolo, director of the "Limes" magazine and the General Giuseppe Cucchi, the scientific Advisor of the "Limes" magazine.
- 2) The 14th October, in BRUSSELS: as part of the «*Meeting Place*» organized by the European Committee of the Regions, the Abruzzo Region is coordinating a Partnership composed of 8 organizations from 6 Member States, including the Region of Bratislava (SK), the Regional Economic Development Agency for Sumadija and Pomoravlje, Kragujevac (RS), the Agency for Adult and Further Education (DE), the National University of Ireland, Maynooth (IE), and the association of SVIMEZ, that is to say the Association for the Development of the Industry in the Mezzogiorno (IT). In collaboration with the promoters of the European project «Regional», members of the IDP European Consultants in Pescara, the results of a comparative analysis about the strategies and the policies applied in 21 European regions for the development of the human capital will be presented as a solution to the crisis. The *toolkit* will be provided by policymakers in order to plan policies of effective training.
- 3) The 15th October, in BRUSSELS: the Abruzzo Region will have its contribute to the discussion about the "Role of the Adriatic-Ionian Macroregion in the growth and employment" during a conference organized by the partners, related to the Adriatic and Ionian Macroregion. The partnership is composed of 14 organizations which represent 7 Member States. In addition to the Abruzzo Region, these regions are also part of the event: the Dubrovnik-Neretva County (HR), Slovenia (SE), Montenegro (ME), Friuli Venezia Giulia, Marche, Apulia, Calabria, Sicily and Emilia-Romagna (considered as a leader partner) (IT), Republika Srpska, Sarajevo (BA), South Eastern Serbia (RS), and Croatia (EL).
