

MED OSMoSIS. The Abruzzo Region successfully closes the capitalisation phase

Developing a number of modules and applications on **Maritime Surveillance** and facilitating the exchange of information for the purpose of further developing interoperable systems at transnational level, in order **to ensure and improve data sharing management** in the Mediterranean macro-region. This is the key goal of the Interreg MED Programme-funded project OSMoSIS, in which the Abruzzo Region is responsible for Work Package 6 “Capitalising”.

In view of capitalising on the project results, the partnership was called to cooperate in the definition of the **Action plan for mainstreaming the results**, the **Policy Recommendations** endorsed by the **Memorandum of Understanding** each partner will sign with their stakeholders, in order to ensure the sustainability and embedding of the outcomes.

In particular, on the one hand, the Policy Recommendations will guarantee that the voices of the territories involved in the project and that worked hand in hand throughout nearly 3 years of project implementation will be heard and embedded in the future actions the European Commission will undertake in the area. While on the other, the Action plan for mainstreaming the results suggests possible actions that could be embarked on, so to treasure the lessons learnt during the project lifespan.

The work team of the Abruzzo Region was in charge of drawing up the documents and contributed with ideas and a vision stemming from the analysis of the on-the-field work and pilot actions carried out by the partners.

The approval of all the capitalisation deliverables **confirms the successful closing** of the project activities on the part of the Abruzzo Region and lay the grounds for improved cooperation in the sector of the governance of maritime surveillance across the Mediterranean region.
