


MIMOSA. The first meeting for the establishment of the local Sustainable Mobility Quality Partnership Group

The Abruzzo Region is an active partner of MIMOSA - **Maritime and Multimodal Sustainable Passenger transport solutions and services** funded by the Italy-Croatia Programme. The project aims at proposing intermodal and sustainable maritime passenger transport solutions at the benefit of the coastline areas along Italy and Croatia.

On March 29th, 2022, the experts of the Abruzzo Region organised an online meeting with [SNAM](#), one of the world's leading energy infrastructure operators - the first step for the establishment of the local Sustainable Mobility Quality Partnership Group (SMQPG). The group aims to **transfer and capitalise on the results of the project starting from the regional context**, and to **feed into the cross-border dialogue** on the promotion of sustainable mobility via an online platform, the MIMOSA cross-border network, that has the key goal to ensure the sustainability of the project also after its lifespan. In this regard, the project pursues the goal to create 14 SMQPGs, one per partner.

The meeting was organised in collaboration with [CITRaMS – Research Centre on sustainable transport and mobility](#), the technical and scientific partner of the Region in this project, engaged in the development of a pilot action intending to **verify the feasibility of a low-carbon maritime link between Abruzzo and Croatia** by analyzing alternative solutions for vessel fueling, such as LNG.

The meeting was successful not only in terms of the possibility of completing the data collection for the pilot studies carried out by CITRaMS; SNAM also ensured to give all the support possible to the pilot action and the transferring of the outcomes, as well as to reinforcing the regional network of stakeholders.

The Abruzzo Region and CITRaMS have already identified the stakeholders who will be part of this regional network, in line with the goals set by the project, namely working in synergy with the regional transport operators at all levels, so to be able to **ensure consistency of the pilot actions with the regional and national policies**, thus obtaining the highest impact in terms of promotion of sustainable mobility.

Other on-line meetings are envisaged in the scope of this activity shortly.
