"YOUTH AND BRUSSELS BASED REGIONS", LAUNCH OF THE 4th CALL: FOUR YOUNG *ABRUZZESI* FOR THE TYE AT THE BRUSSELS' OFFICE. EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST BY THE 8th MARCH

Launch of the project's fourth call for the "Youth and Brussels based Regions" project. From today until the 8th March, all young people who meet the conditions for eligibility indicated in the **Public Notice** published on the Abruzzo Region's website (http://goo.gl/hhRCfh) can express their interests to be part of the following PLACEMENTS:

TRANSNATIONAL EXCHANGES – MULTILATERAL SPRING 1 = 16 placements from the 22nd April to the 5th May 2015 (4 for the ABRUZZO Region, 4 for the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, 4 for the LUBUSKIE Province, and 4 for the PRESOV Region)

CONDITIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY:

- to be between 18 and 25 years old
- to be born in the Abruzzo Region, in the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, in the LUBUSKIE Province or in the PRESOV Region, or to live in the Abruzzo Region, in the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, in the LUBUSKIE Province or in the PRESOV Region, or to study in a training establishment, even at university, in the Abruzzo Region, in the DUBROVNIK-NERETVA County, in the LUBUSKIE Province or in the PRESOV Region
- to work, or to be unemployed, or to be looking for a first job

Furthermore, a good knowledge of a foreign language (if possible English) will play an **important role**: the young people who will go to **Brussels** will work in a **multicultural** and **multilingual** context. They will have to interact with each other and will act as an "antenna" for the others who will follow them at home, via the online platform and the project's social networks accounts.

EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE AND TRANSNATIONAL EXCHANGES IN BRUSSELS

"Youth and Brussels based Regions" is a European project promoted and coordinated by the Abruzzo Region, in partnership with the Dubrovnik-Neretva County (Croatia), the Lubuskie Province (Poland) and the Presov Region (Slovakia).

The project was approved by the European Commission and it is co-financed by the "Youth in Action" program. It shall take effect from the 1st May 2014 until the 30th April 2016. During that two-year period, it intends to send 80 young people, aged 18-30, in the respective regional offices in Brussels for European voluntary service (EVS) and transnational youth exchanges (TYE) programs.

The project was presented on the 17th May 2014 in Brussels, at the Committee of the Regions, during the Institutions' traditional "Open Doors Day".

The people who will benefit from that exceptional offer will be selected among unemployed young people (aged 18-30) as far as the **European voluntary service** program is concerned, and among young workers and unemployed young people aged 18-25 as far as the **transnational exchanges** program is concerned.

The conditions and the duration vary depending on the programs: the European voluntary service program lasts for 13 weeks and the transnational exchanges program last for 2 weeks. Food and accommodation expenses are covered, as well as the travel costs. As far as the European voluntary service program is concerned, the candidates selected will also receive a monthly pocket money.

Every aspect of the project, including the selection, will be managed **online**, on the website, in digital form, in order to ensure high level of objectivity, transparency and rapidity. All interested people who meet the conditions for eligibility indicated in the public notice related to the first year are kindly invited to visit regularly the website to participate in surveys and other activities offered, but also to respond to notices as soon as they are posted on the website.

The activities' launch coincided with the **fifteenth anniversary** of the establishment of the Abruzzo Region's office in Brussels (1999/2014).

RESULTS AFTER NINE MONTHS OF ACTIVITY

Nine months after the launch, the project has already been very successful, with 9,000 visits on the website and over 320 registered users.

Among the registered users, 74 people (including 62 *abruzzes*i) asked to be part of the last call, the third, related to the European voluntary service from the 12th January to the 12th April.

Furthermore, about 100 users participated in the informative survey related to the project's themes.
